



## Parent Academic Responsibility

Parents are responsible for providing all curriculum and supplies from the provided list and any additional materials needed for occasional projects.

**Math** - Two math lessons will be completed at the co-op with your student's teacher. Parents will need to complete two math lessons with their students before they return to the co-op on Tuesday. We suggest and encourage parents to review lessons completed on co-op days and add any additional work needed and continue working on any concepts that are not completely understood by your student.

**Language Arts** - Two language arts lessons will be completed at the co-op with your student's teacher. Parents will need to complete two language lessons with their students before they return to the co-op on Tuesday. We suggest and encourage parents to review lessons completed on co-op days and add any additional work needed and continue working on any concepts that are not completely understood by your student.

**Spelling** - All students will practice spelling in an age appropriate capacity. Third grade students and older will be given a spelling list on Tuesday as well as completing activities with the spelling words during the co-op day. Parents should review these words with their student and continue their choice of activities on Wednesday to prepare for a test like activity on Thursday.

**Music/Theatre** - There will be a program each semester that will need students to practice lines or songs at home in addition to what is done at the co-op. This will be communicated with parents in advance.

**All Additional Classes** - All additional classes will complete the curriculum during the co-op days. Parents should review the work that is completed. There may be a project to do at home or additional research needed on a subject but this is limited and will be communicated in advance to parents.
